

EPSOM&DISTRICT WEDNESDAY DARTS LEAGUE

LEAGUE RULES

- 1) The league shall be known as the Epsom & District Dart League
- 2) The league headquarters are Epsom Common Working man`s club, Stamford Green Epsom.
- 3) The league shall be governed by a committee elected each year at the A G M this will consist of :Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer & 4 committee men.
- 4) A general meeting of members will be held each year during the month of August/September. Further meetings will be called as and when necessary, and these will be called through the chairman.
- 5) A full and complete report will be drawn up, plus a statement of accounts to be available for inspection at the A.G.M
- 6) **EACH TEAM MUST HAVE A REPRESENTATIVE AT ALL MEETINGS AS NOTIFIED. ONLY ONE VOTE FOR ANY TEAM WILL BE ALLOWED.**
- 7) All funds will be kept in the name of EPSOM & DISTRICT DART LEAGUE.
- 8) A membership fee of £40.00 (from 2001) will be paid before the start of the season for every team. This money is non refundable should any team drop out.
- 9) In addition to the league programme, competitions will also be held as follows
BEN HILL EIGHTS: This will consist of the best of 3 legs of 1001
FOURS: Teams of 5 any 4 of which to play in 1 game, best of 3 legs of 901
PAIRS: Two players (no subs) best of 3 legs of 701
SINGLES: Best of 3 legs of 501
CHAIRMANS CUP: One game of 1501
SECRETARIES CUP: Play off for overall winner ROUND ROBIN best of 3 of 501
The competitions will be held at the discretion of the committee during the course of the season. All finals will be held at a venue at the end of the season where the presentation will be made.
All competitions are open to registered players in the league. There will be an entry fee of £1.00 per person for all competitions, except the eights which is free.
All players must sign in by 8.15pm for a prompt start of 8.30pm, if this is not adhered to, the offending player/players will be scrubbed
- 10) There will be trophies awarded for the most tons, most game shots in each division also for the highest get out.
COMPETITIONS DO NOT QUALIFY FOR THESE AWARDS
- 11) Any player who gets out in any match on 170, will be awarded a memento to commemorate this achievement.
COMPETITIONS DO NOT QUALIFY.
- 12) Any marshals at the competitions should be aware of the correct procedure of the draw, ie any byes go in the 1st round. It is not always possible for committee members to be at every venue for the competitions, so anyone not familiar with the correct procedure should seek advice, either prior to the event or from a competitor who does have this knowledge.
- 13) **ANY TEAM GIVING LESS THAN 24 HOURS NOTICE OF POSTPONEMENT OR FAILING TO TURN UP... WILL FORFEIT THE GAME 10 - NIL**
- 14) No cancellation will be accepted from any team who has 12 or more players signed on.RULE 13 WILL APPLY
